Agricultural and Migrant Farmworker Services

Idaho Legal Aid Services' (ILAS) offices provide the following kinds of help for migrants in the regions of **Boise**, **Caldwell**, **Idaho Falls**, and **Twin Falls**:

- domestic violence
- health and public benefits (Medicaid, Food Stamps, Temporary Assistance for Families in Idaho (TAFI)
- immigration
- education
- employment
- consumer
- housing

In order to be **eligible**, you must be the following:

- a low-income household
- a citizen or have eligible alien status
- farm workers (may include sheep herders, diary and processing employees, rock quarry workers)

Some exceptions are:

- ILAS may help an ineligible Alien who has been abused or a victim of extreme cruelty as long as our help is directly related to the abuse.
- If ILAS does not have enough resources and/or staff to assist, they may not be able to take the case.
