Your caseload will primarily consist of housing, public entitlements, guardianships, elder law, and family law where there is domestic violence. The position also includes outreach and education to individuals and organizations that serve our client community, which may include LGBTQ, unhoused, refugee, veteran, immigrant, and Latino groups.

The attorney will be based out of our Coeur d’Alene, Idaho, Office, which serves the First Judicial District. The city is located on stunning Coeur d’Alene Lake. Coeur d’Alene is a growing community with a high quality of life, vibrant downtown, excellent restaurants and amenities, and outdoor recreation in every direction.
