With a degree in Political Science and Speech Communication from Trinity University (San Antonio, TX), Greg coordinated federally-funded programs for at-risk youth in Fort Worth, Texas from 1992-2000. Upon moving to Boise in 2001, he supervised the Hays Shelter Home serving runaway and homeless youth, and managed Community House for the City of Boise in 2005. In 2006, Greg developed and implemented CATCH (Charitable Assistance To Community's Homeless) which re-houses and serves homeless families with children. CATCH has been honored and recognized for its innovation by the National League of Cities, CH2MHill, the National Alliance to End Homelessness, United States Interagency Council of Homelessness, and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. Greg also served as the City of Boise's ADA and Fair Housing Coordinator from 2005-2011. He currently serves as the Executive Director of CATCH, Inc. which has programs in Ada and Canyon Counties.
