Safety after Leaving an Abusive Relationship

- 1. Change the locks.
- 2. Install as many security features as possible in your home.
- 3. Inform neighbors that your former partner is not welcome on the premises.
- 4. Make sure the people who care for your children are very clear about who does and does not have permission to pick up your children.
- 5. Obtain a civil protection order.
- 6. Let your co-workers know about the situation.
- 7. Avoid the stores, banks, and businesses you used when you were living with your batterer. Change your routine and make it unpredictable to your partner. For example, shop in a different grocery store at a different time each week, drive on different roads to and from work and use the buddy system when going to places that your partner knows you frequent.

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
